



The Stanley Road Experiences Curriculum
Nursery – Year 6

Introduction

At Stanley Road we recognise that the curriculum we provide should extend beyond purely academic learning to include a range of activities that we believe all pupils should experience before they leave us in Year 6. Pupils' involvement in these activities is not assessed – the very act of taking part is sufficient. As a result of these experiences, our pupils develop a richer understanding of the world and have opportunities to take part in activities which they may not otherwise get the chance to do.
